**** The first person definitely known to have used the name of Woolworth in this country was Richard Wooley or Woolworth who settled at Newbury(port), MA in 1678. Born in 1648, he was then thirty years old, and by profession, "weaver for the King's Bench". He may have been the son of an earlier Richard Wooley, born in England in 1600 who sailed from Gravesend on the "Plain Jane." This sailing vessel landed in Virginia on May 15, 1635. At that date, British authorities encouraged settlement in Virginia at the expense of the New England colonies. Hence, many persons landed in Virginia and then moved to a more northern colony. By the fall of 1678, Richard Woolworth was required to take an oath of allegiance. Life became more complex for him too, as he met and wooed young Hannah Huggins. They were married on Christmas Eve of that year.

The young couple lived in Newbury(port) for a few years, but then removed up the broad CT River to Suffield, CT, an area which had been devastated by the bitter King Phillip's War with the local Wampanoag Indians. Richard Woolworth had prepared for this move by asking for a grant of land which he received in August, 1680. He obtained more land in 1681, 1684 and 1688. Two children survived them; they were Hannah, born Feb. 10, 1681/1682 and Richard, born December 6, 1687. Hannah (Huggins) Woolworth died on October 19, 1691 and Richard, her husband, died on December 20, 1696. Both appear to have been buried in Suffield. The courts allowed Hannah to administer her parent's estate though she was then only fifteen years old. She married John Gleason Feb. 15, 1704.
