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### Cross Machine Inc. Berry Hydro Rake For Sale

The City of Watertown has a surplus 1997 Cross Machine Berry Hydro Rake for sale. The machine is currently at the City-owned Hydro-electric plant on the Black River in Watertown, New York.

- The machine has 1,629 hours of use.
- The boom is a 3 section telescoping type, made of A-500 Grade B tubing.
- The rake has an approximate 30 foot reach, a lifting capacity of 3,000 pounds, and a travel speed of 25 feet per minute.
- The rake head is 8 feet wide with a 12 cubic foot capacity.
- The mobile gantry travels at 50 feet per minute on “v” grooved rails.
- The debris hopper has a 165 cubic foot capacity with a hydraulic dump.
- The machine has a heated control cab with electric over hydraulic controls.
- The hydraulic system has an 80 gallon reservoir, 20hp 480v 3 phase motor, and a 29 gpm pump.

#### **NOTE:**

**This is an “as-is” sale. The rake has been removed from the rack deck, and is sitting on the ground near the deck. The successful bidder will take possession of the rake as it is. It has been separated into three components; the main body, the boom, and the trash bin.**

**The bidder is responsible for the cost of loading the rake onto the transport vehicle, and the shipping cost of transporting the rake to its final destination. These costs are in no way to be incurred by the City of Watertown, or considered as part of the bid price.**

**The bidder must provide proof of liability and Worker’s Compensation Insurance with bid. The City accepts form “ACORD 25” for the liability insurance, and “C-105.2” or “U-26.3” for the Worker’s Compensation Insurance. On site work will not be allowed to being until all insurance information is turned into the city engineer’s office.**

**The bidder will be liable for all property damage and personal injuries that occur once they take possession of the trash rake from the City of Watertown. Possession occurs once the bidder has successfully won the auction. All sales are final, the winning bidder will have 30 days to remove the rake from the site, and all of the rake must be removed from the site.**
